

Who can use Kialla House?

Kialla House is available to carers of frail older people who need a break from their caring role.

Referrals

Referrals to Kialla House can be made by carers, health care professionals or community agencies by contacting Villa Maria Northern Victoria Community Services on (03) 5832 8444 or (03) 5722 9046.

A Case Manager from Villa Maria will visit the referred person in their home to determine if Kialla House will suit their needs. In consultation with their carer, an appropriate respite care plan is then developed.

What is the cost?

There is a minimal cost per day, however no person will be refused respite due to an inability to pay. Invoices are issued at the end of each month from Villa Maria's central office in Kew, Melbourne.
